POLICY

The Board encourages the ongoing advocacy that staff and volunteers (including board members) perform in the daily execution of their duties. The Board will provide direction and support so that Country roads Community Health Center can effectively advocate on behalf of the community and clients on issues that have an impact on their overall health and well-being. Those issues may arise from within or outside the organization. The Board, with advice from the Executive Director, is responsible for any advocacy positions the organization takes. In considering possible advocacy issues, the Board will consider relevance of the issue to CRCHC's mission, vision, values and strategic direction.

We define "advocacy" as "actions taken: to establish, recommend, defend and support positions that strengthen the health and well-being of individuals and communities".
